ANALISA SONDERGAARD for Magisterial District Judge, District 15-4-01: Analisa won both the Democratic and Republican ballots in the 2017 Primary and thus runs unopposed in the general election. She was first elected in 2011 and is seeking a second term. Her district includes much of Tredyffrin Township and most of East Whiteland Township. She is a graduate of Temple Law School. She worked for the Philadelphia District Attorney's Office for 8 years. After leaving the DA's office, she entered private practice and worked as a litigator representing clients in both state and federal courts. Analisa has been endorsed by the Tredyffrin Township Police Association and the Chester County Fraternal Order of Police Lodge 11.
