

<p>INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTER</p> <p>1. TO VOTE YOU MUST COMPLETELY BLACKEN THE OVAL (●) TO THE LEFT OF YOUR CHOICE. An oval (●) blackened to the left of any candidate indicates a vote for that candidate.</p> <p>2. To vote a Straight Party Ticket, completely darken the oval next to the Party for which you wish to vote. This will automatically cast a vote for all candidates of your chosen Party, in all contests. You may also vote for candidate(s) of another Party, in a specific contest, by completely darkening the oval next to his or her name. This action will not void your Straight Party vote for other candidates, in other contests.</p> <p>3. To cast a write-in vote for a person whose name is not on the ballot, you must blacken the oval to the left of the line provided, and print the name in the blank space provided for that purpose.</p> <p>4. To vote in FAVOR of a Question, fill in the oval to the left of the word YES. To vote AGAINST a Question, fill in the oval to the left of the word NO.</p> <p>5. Use only a black pen or marker.</p> <p>6. If you make a mistake DO NOT ERASE. This is NOT a vote to eliminate property taxes.

A yes vote would change the state constitution to allow homestead exemptions of up to 100%. The current limit is 50%. Any change in this exemption also would require the passage of a new state law and changes by the county, municipality and/or school district.
